The Corral passes are valid for the 4 days of the event and cost \$40 per vehicle. The Saturday paddock/GA passes are usually \$90 per pass and until July 1<sup>st</sup> we can provide these passes at \$72 which is a 20% discount. Discounted Paddock passes are only available with a Corral purchase. This offer is available to all Jaguar owners.
